

ABOUT TARGETED RECRUITMENT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) has expanded its traditional workforce retention and training model by recruiting doctors to targeted remote communities with high medical workforce need. The aim is to enhance the attractiveness of rural and remote posts to high quality applicants to provide communities with a well-supported and sustainable GP workforce.

The initial pilot of the program in 2018-19 has successfully secured the services of six full-time doctors to six rural and remote communities across Australia.

Targeted recruitment positions utilise existing RVTS training positions and infrastructure. The training is fully funded by the Australian Government and is a four-year GP training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP.



Location



Robinvale is located 477km north-west of Melbourne via the Murray Valley Highway. It is 88km south-east of Mildura and 134km from Swan Hill. Known as a popular holiday destination, Robinvale sits on a peninsula of land that is surrounded on three of its sides by the Murray River.



Attractions



Whether it is swimming, camping, a picnic or spot of fishing, Robinvale on the banks of the Murray River is your go-to destination. The huge Southern Cross Windmill is a popular tourist destination and talking point of the town. The Euston Weir and Lock 15, located just out of Robinvale, are also popular.




Housing

The Robinvale District Medical Centre is a thriving, fully equipped and mixed billing practice providing medical services to the residents of Robinvale and surrounds.

The medical centre has three consulting rooms operated by the general practitioners who are supported by practice nurses and administrative staff.

Family medicine, chronic disease management, drug and alcohol issues and aged care are some of the main medical issues treated by the clinic.

Doctors from the clinic provide an on-call service and have visiting rights to the Robinvale District Health Service.

The hospital is located within walking distance to the clinic and hospital rounds are carried out every morning before the clinic opens for the day.

The health service operates 20 acute beds, 55 residential aged care beds (including high and low care) and also provides urgent and emergency care to both the Robinvale and Manangatang communities.

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander population of Robinvale is 8.1 per cent.
