RVTS ENHANCED TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 20 doctors to 24 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 9 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location

Clermont is 3 hours from Mackay, 4.5 hours from Rockhampton, 80 minutes from Emerald and 5 hours from Townsville. Flights are available from Emerald. Clermont is a major hub for the large coal mines in the region.



Attractions

The historic mining town features sporting facilities, golf course and the Theresa Creek Dam for skiing and freshwater barramundi fishing. Peak Range National Park offers bushwalking and photography, with spectacular geological features, views and historical interest.



Housing
