RVTS ENHANCED TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 24 doctors to 26 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 9 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location



Located on the banks of the Warrego river, Charleville is the largest town in Queensland's south-west and is a hub for visitors and pastoralists alike. It is accessible via to Brisbane (750km), Toowoomba (610km), Dalby (400km), and Roma (250km), with daily flights to Brisbane.



Attractions

Housing



Accommodation support is provided with the position either via Queensland Health housing or a rental subsidy. The Median house price in Charleville is \$152,000 and with median rent at \$250 per week.

Katanning is serviced by 3 schools. Charleville State School (K-6), St Marys Parish School (K-6), Charleville State High School (7-12) and the School of the Air. There is also a kindergarten and daycare facilities located in the town.
