## RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 23 doctors to 26 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 10 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



### Location



This picturesque township is situated on the coastline of Western Eyre Peninsula in South Australia located 110km (one hour) from Ceduna, 300km (three hours) from Port Lincoln and 380km (four hours) from Whyalla. Flights to Adelaide are available from Ceduna.



### Attractions



The area boasts endless sandy beaches, countless fishing spots and some of SA's best surfing beaches along a spectacular coastline. The town has great cafes, boutique style retail shops, sporting and fitness groups, with a friendly local community.



### Housing



Housing can be negotiated within the employment contract. Streaky Bay is a vibrant regional community experiencing significant growth - this growth will create many local opportunities. Median house price is \$360,000 and \$205 per week for rent.



### Education



Streaky Bay has an area school, catering for preschool through to year 12. There is a private and public primary/secondary school also located in Ceduna.

### Referring Hospitals



The Streaky Bay District Hospital is next door to the clinic, with 10 acute care and nine high care aged care beds.

An additional 15 low care aged care beds are located nearby at the Elmhaven Hostel.



### Services



Allied health services including dietetics, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, podiatry, speech therapy and child/adolescent health are available.

The hospital provides general medical and surgical care, including minor day surgery.



### Visiting Specialists



Shared care arrangements with GPs and community midwives assist women with care and treatment before and after childbirth. Birthing facilities are available at Ceduna and Port Lincoln.

A wide range of services are accessible via tele-health.
