The Organisation

Durri Aboriginal Corporation Medical Service (ACMS) is an Aboriginal Community Controlled Primary Health Service. For over 40 years, Durri ACMS has provided essential and culturally appropriate health care to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people located in Kempsey, Nambucca Heads and surrounding communities.

Our primary health service site in Kempsey is located on the traditional lands of the Dunghutti people, extending from the eastern extremity of the Mid North Coast to the Northern Tablelands. Our Nambucca clinic sits in the homeland of the Gumbaynggirr people, with the Nambucca Valley being the southern gateway to subtropical Australia.

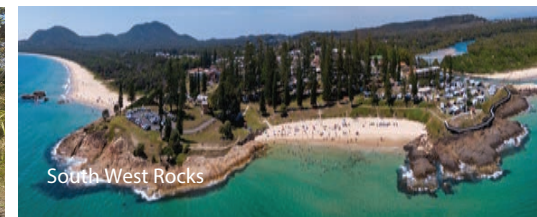

The Location

The Mid North Coast of New South Wales is home to some of Australia's most beautiful coastline, offering excellent access to surfing, fishing, boating and water sports.

It is abundant with beautiful winding rivers and lush hinterlands that present countless opportunities to explore picturesque walking trails, historical sites and camping spots.

Natural wonders combined with friendly communities and burgeoning businesses gives the Mid North Coast its unique work life balance.

The primary health facility of Durri ACMS is nestled on the banks of the Macleay River in the CBD of the Kempsey township. Kempsey is a significant rural centre and a popular stop for people travelling from Sydney to Brisbane. It is only 15 minutes

from stunning coast including one of Australia's best beaches, Killick Beach.

The seaside hub of Port Macquarie, known for its beaches, surfing and fishing, is just 40 minutes from Kempsey, offering easy access to national parks, restaurants, vineyards and shopping.

Durri ACMS' Nambucca clinic is based at Nambucca Heads. Located halfway between Sydney and Brisbane, Nambucca Heads is less than half a day's drive from either capital city. The average temperature is 19°C in winter and 27°C in summer.

The city of Coffs Harbor is just a 35-minute drive from Nambucca Heads, boasting stunning national parks and marine parks and ample opportunities to shop, dine and play.
